## Fabulous Fall Recipe—Yummy!!

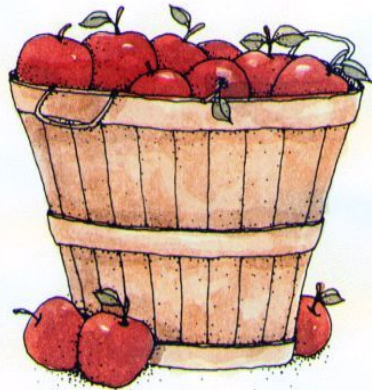
### Crockpot Apple Stuffing

- |                             |   |
|-----------------------------|---|
| 1/2 cup butter or margarine | 14 oz pkg. cubed herbed seasoned stuffing mix |
| 1 cup chopped walnuts       | 1-1/2 cups applesauce                         |
| 2 onions, chopped           | 1 cup water                                   |

In large skillet, melt 2 Tbsp. butter and cook walnuts over medium heat until toasted and fragrant, stirring frequently (about 5 min). Remove nuts from skillet and place in small dish-set aside.

Melt remaining 6 Tbsp. butter in the same skillet. Add onion and cook for 3-4 minutes.

Spray 4-6 quart slow cooker with nonstick spray and place stuffing cubes in prepared crockpot. Add cooked onion with butter and mix gently. Add applesauce and water and mix lightly. Cover and cook on low for 4-5 hours. Sprinkle with toasted walnuts before serving. Makes 10 3/4 cup servings.

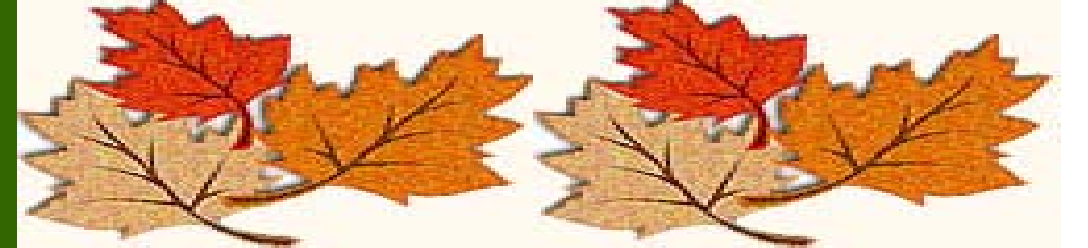

## Keeping It Safe

Things to do EVERY SINGLE DAY:

Keep ALL doors and windows locked. (This goes for your house, car and garage!) If it is difficult to get inside your house, garage or car, a criminal is more likely to move on to an easier target.

Keep lights on at the entrances and exits to your home or garage. Park your vehicle near or under an overhead light. Criminals will look for a less appealing and unlit target.

Set timers on appliances or lights when you are out. A criminal is less likely to enter an occupied home!

Be alert to suspicious activity or persons and call the Tallahassee Police Department to report suspicious activity by dialing 891-4200.

Asking police to respond to your street when suspicious activity occurs sends a message to criminals to move along...they are being watched.

colored paper or paper and markers/crayons

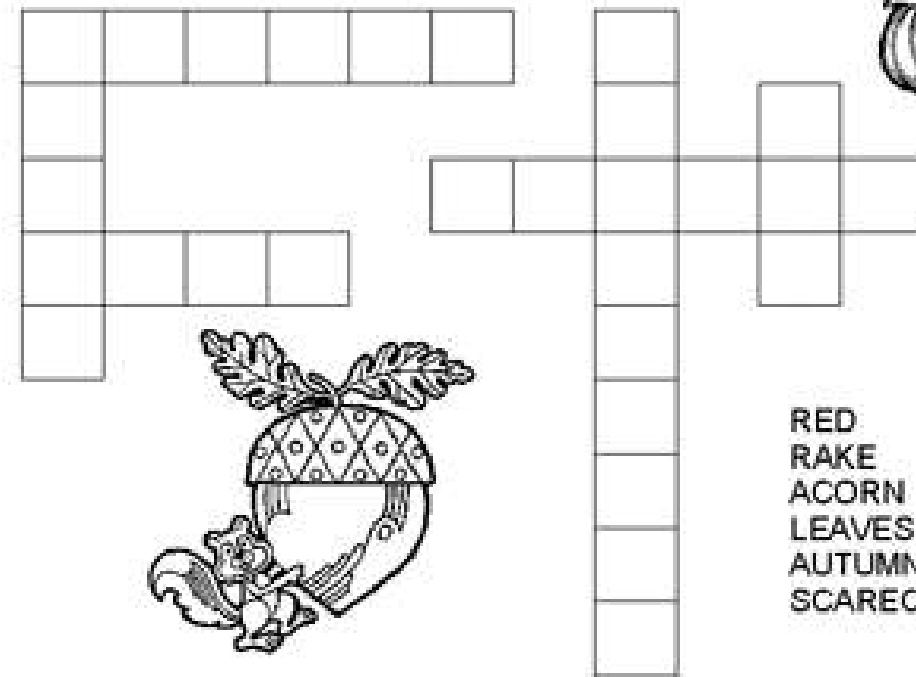


#### Directions

- Use colored paper, picture pages from magazines, or have the kids color patterns on white paper.
- Cut out feathers from the colored paper. Make slits along the side just like feathers.

- Glue the head on the small end of the pinecone.
